

Distributing Presentations created in Adobe Presenter

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Adding Adobe Presenter-created Content to BlackBoard

This document describes the process of adding Adobe Presenter-generated content to a BlackBoard Learning Management System (LMS) implementation. While the user interface for your LMS may look different, the steps outlined below are a standard process in BlackBoard.

1. Click on the Create Zip File option when you generate your presentation in Adobe Presenter.
2. You can then upload it into Blackboard. Log into your Blackboard course and select the **Control Panel** button to find the content area where you would like to post presentations (example: Course Documents).
3. Add an item with the **+Item** button.

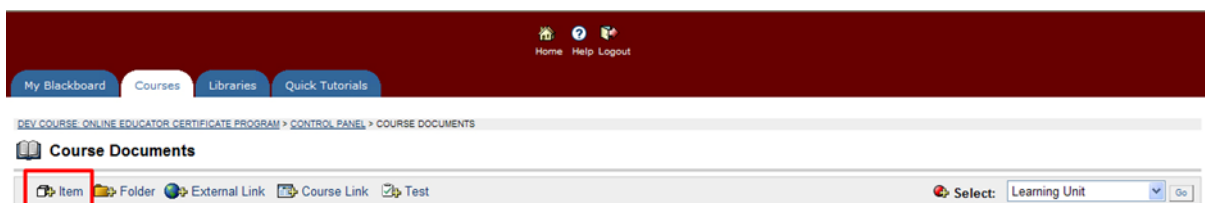


Figure 1 Add Item to BlackBoard

4. Enter the appropriate information in the **Name** and **Text** boxes. Under **Content Attachments**, select the Browse button to attach the appropriate .zip file on your computer.
5. In the **Special Action** box, select **Unpackage this File**. After you submit, the next form you see is **File Options**. Select **index.html** as the entry point then submit this form.

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7. Go back to the content area where you linked your presentation (example: **Course Documents**). You will see the name you specified and the link to the package file. This link will take your students to the presentation, which opens within their browser window.

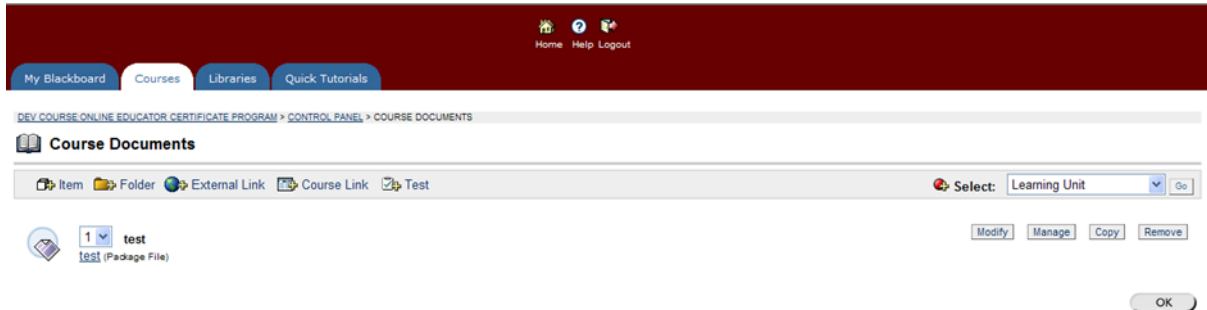


Figure 4 Course Documents screen with added content

8. Follow steps 1-9 each time you want to have a presentation uploaded and linked into Blackboard.
9. Remind students that they must have a current version of **Flash Player** installed on their computers to successfully see the presentations.
